Alexandria City Public Schools is assembling its 2017-2018 Teacher Leadership Project. TLP is a cohort of Pre-K through 12th grade teachers interested in becoming technology leaders and collaborating with others across the division.

TLP IS AN OPPORTUNITY TO:

- create an exemplary classroom that integrates technology to expand learning.
- experiment and take risks in order to foster critical thinking and problem solving.
- gain experience leading and facilitating technology-rich learning opportunities for staff.

COHORT STRUCTURE:

- 2 full day workshops during the summer (August 22 and 23)
- 3 full day workshops during the year (October 5, January 25, March 1)
- 3 after-school meetings (November 9, December 7, April 26)
- Gallery walk presentation (May 10)
- Ongoing collaboration in-person and online

COHORT BENEFITS:

- 120 recertification points
- Equipment needed to facilitate teaching and learning in your classroom
- \$300 stipend
- Collaborative learning community
